You'll need internet access on a computer, tablet or phone. You can contact the Diversion Office to set up a time to come into the Diversion Office to do the course if you want to use our computer. *(It is recommended to use Chrome, Firefox, or Safari)*

1. Click on **GET YOUR REQUIRED COURSE HERE** on top of page and then **ENROLL IN A COURSE**
2. Enter your **COURSE CONTROL NUMBER** (exactly as given to you by your Diversion Officer) in the Search by Control Number BOX and click CONTINUE
3. **VERIFY** your course information and click **CONTINUE** to complete the enrollment process.

You will receive a **PASSWORD** immediately once you have provided all enrollment and payment information. **Be sure to write down your login (email), password -now- before you begin, and answers to your validation questions during the course.** You can begin your class at this time or when you are ready to begin the course by going to the homepage and login with your email address and the password you were given. You can login and out as needed to finish the course with that login and password.

You must complete the course work on your own. You're subject to validation during and after completion of the course. Incorrect responses to validation questions can result in not being able to continue with the class, loss of grades and a negative report to the Diversion Office.

Most of the above classes take about 3 to 4 hours to complete. The Nicotine 101 takes approximately 1 hour. Some of the courses require you to use audio and the audio segments may be timed. If you fail a section or lesson quiz, you can retake it again. You will not be able to advance until you have successfully completed each section.

You will receive an email notification upon completion of the course. A Certificate of Completion will also go directly to the Diversion Office.
