HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE CLASS

How It Works: Classes are available online, 24/7 and are self-paced. Complete from any computer, mobile device, or tablet. Your time is registered when you're logged in and your work is saved when you log out. You can log in and out as many times as necessary to finish the class.

STEP 1: Go to: www.HallCountyClass.com and select the correct class that is checked above -- "ENROLL" here (yellow box)

STEP 2: IF you have already registered as a user on this site when completing the Decision Making Class, then click Existing User and Log in with your previous email and password. **If this is the first time for you to this site** then Sign up as a "New User" and click "SUBMIT" (Be sure to keep track of the email and password you use to enroll)

STEP 3: Complete your class and print your certificate

HOW TO RESUME/RETURN TO YOUR CLASS

- STEP 1:** Go to: www.HallCountyClass.com
- STEP 2:** Look for LOGIN to Resume Your Class
- STEP 3:** Submit your **email address** and **password**
- STEP 4:** Once logged in, click: **“My Training”** to continue your class.

During the course there are times when they will give you a number code/password to remember. Please write that password down because you will need it to continue with the course later on. Do not confuse this code/password with the actual password that you created when you registered. If you fail a chapter, you can immediately retake it to get a passing score.

Please answer all “fill in” and “essay” questions completely. Your Diversion Officer will be able to review all of your answers given to the questions/quiz during the class and may go over them with you during your next appointment.

At the end of the class and final exam the program will ask you if you want a completion certificate --- Be sure to select YES so that you will have a certificate AND that will also generate a copy of your certificate to be sent to the Diversion Office to verify that you have completed the class.
